

A Comment on Maintaining Active Licensure



The Ohio Respiratory Care Board has been licensing respiratory therapists since 1990 and home medical equipment facilities since 2005. Over this period of time the Board has witnessed many changes in health care; changes that have effected the peaks and troughs of the number of persons maintaining ongoing licensure. The economy is certainly an example of change that effects health care. In good economic times, I have often observed individual therapists seeking other opportunities that draw them away from the respiratory care profession. In a bad economy, many therapists return to the profession, because health care, it is arguably believed, weathers the circumstances a little better.

During brief periods or extended periods of non-practice, it is not uncommon that therapists allow their license to lapse or be placed in an inactive status. When or if to decide to inactivate a license is a difficult choice. It is an individual decision to be certain, but I suspect the driving force behind the choice is the cost of maintaining the license when not practicing. Many individuals I have spoken to often say, "I do not think I will ever be practicing again." Years later they return to reactivate the license, because circumstances of life changed only to find the hurdles for reinstatement are difficult. To meet ongoing competency requirements, the Board requires individuals to provide all of the continuing education hours required since the date of expiration or, if the license has been lapsed for more than five years, proof of re-examination at the Certified Respiratory Therapist Level. The fact is, the public deserves qualified competent providers and the Board must have some methodology to determine minimum competence. I do not think any one could argue that the longer one does not practice, the less competent they are.

I have no doubt that a decision to allow a license to lapse is difficult, but so can the work required to reinstate the same license. I would urge licensees to carefully consider this decision. The license you hold has been earned through your great efforts, long hours of study and rigorous examinations. Making the decision to allow a license to lapse should not be taken lightly, in my opinion. The many therapists that hold valid licensure clearly understand their obligation to protect their patients by maintaining ongoing competency and regular evaluation of their skills and knowledge. Board staff are available to assist individuals in understanding the requirements for reinstatement and the process of allowing a license to lapse.

FAQ on Criminal Background Checks

- Q: When did criminal background checks become law?
- A: The Governor signed the bill in early 2008 and the new requirement became law on March 24, 2008. The law requires all professional licensing boards to require criminal background checks for initial licensure.
- Q: Who must obtain a criminal background checks?
- A: All persons seeking a respiratory care professional license or limited permit must cause a criminal background check to be mailed to the Ohio Respiratory Care Board.
- Q: Can I have my employer send a copy of my background check?
- A: No. Ohio law clearly requires the criminal background check must come from the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification (BCI&I) and Investigation. The criminal background check cannot come from any other source.
- Q: What constitutes a valid criminal background check?
- A: A valid criminal background check includes both an Ohio BCI&I civilian background check and a Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) background check. Ohio BCI&I facilitates both background checks. Licensees must submit a separate fee for each and provide board specific information to both the Ohio BCI&I and the FBI.
- Q: If I filed a valid BCI&I civilian background check and FBI background check with my limited permit application, do I need to refile a background check with my subsequent license application?
- A: OAC rule 4761-5-07 states that a criminal background check will not be required if the applicant has caused a criminal background check results report to be filed with the board in accordance with the requirements of this rule within one year prior to the date of initial application. A new criminal background check will be required if the applicant's criminal background check results report on file with the board is greater than one year old based on the filing date of the results report with the board.

Continuing Education on Ohio Law Requirement

New rules implemented on July 1, 2008 requires all licensee to complete 20 contact hours of continuing education every biennial renewal cycle and for some limited permit holders (issued under ORC 4761.05 (B)(1)(b)) to complete 10 contact hours of continuing education each annual renewal. Of the hours required, the new rule states that one (1) contact hour must include education in medical or professional ethics or laws regulating the practice of respiratory care. The Board has approved many continuing education courses that meet the medical or professional ethics requirement. These courses are generally individual course offerings. The Board; however, offers one (1) free contact hour on Ohio laws or rules regulating the practice of respiratory care. The Board has contract with Quia.com to offer this course. Here's how it is done:

1. Go to the Quia website at <http://www.quia.com/web>. Select, "Student Zone." When the next page appears, click the button labeled, "Create my free account."
2. Select, "Student" as the account type.
3. Fill out the form that appears using first initial and last name as the user name. Quia will provide a password for your account.
4. When done, press the, "Create my account" button. (Write down the username and password for future reference. The Board does not collect password data.
5. After enrolled, type the [six-character] QUIA class code provided on the Ohio Respiratory Care Board's course listing site that corresponds to the course to complete and push the "add class" button. When the class name, instructor name, and "Class page" appear you may view the class page to do the module. Click on the "[http://quia.com/pages/\[program title\]](http://quia.com/pages/[program title])" link next to the word "Class page."
6. The quiz is at the end of the class material. Click on the link for the quiz and answer the questions. USERNAME AND PASSWORD ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE QUIZ.
7. If quiz score is greater than 70%) it is successfully completed .
8. Print a copy of the score/results page to use as "the certificate of completion." Make sure to sign the score sheet and record the date of completion on it. **Please note that the score sheet does not look like a traditional certificate of completion.**

State Passes New Law on Accessing Sensitive Information by State Employees

The State of Ohio has passed a new law, effective on April 7, 2008, regulating the access of personal information by State Employees. The new law requires State Employees to log accesses to sensitive information maintained by the agency. The law amends chapter 1347 of the Ohio Revised Code. Each state agency is required to adopt new rules that identify, among many things, criteria identifying which state employees may access confidential personal information, a list of valid reasons related to the agency's powers and duties for which the agency may access confidential information, and procedures for accessing the information.



How will this new requirement effect the Ohio Respiratory Care Board? The Ohio Respiratory Care Board is required to collect specific confidential information data on licensees. For example, section 3123.50 of the Ohio Revised Code requires the Board to obtain social security numbers on initial and renewal applications. Federal law under the Health-care Integrity and Protection Data requires the Board to report social security number information. To comply with the new law, the Board will be reviewing all of the records maintained by the agency to determine if the record or information contained on the record is confidential or sensitive in nature, excluding any public information. The Board will then classify each record accordingly. This review will also permit the Board to determine if the record necessarily requires the collection of confidential information. Reduction in collection and consolidation of records that hold sensitive or confidential information will be reviewed.

Governor Appoints Board Member



Governor Strickland appointed Darrell L. Heckman, Attorney at Law to the Ohio Respiratory Care Board on 8/13/08. Mr. Heckman is practicing attorney from Urbana, Ohio. Mr. Heckman will serve as the Board's Public Member for the second time. Mr. Heckman was also

appointed to the Board by then Governor George Voinovich in 1997, reappointed by Governor Bob Taft in 2000. Mr. Heckman left the Board in 2003. The Board is proud to have Mr. Heckman back. During his first two terms on the Board he served as hearing officer and President of the Board for many years.

2009 Renewals are Coming

Annual limited permit renewal applications will be mailed on or after March 1, 2009. The renewal process has no changed. Limited Permit holders will be asked to file renewal applications by mail. The Board recommends that applications be filed at least 15 days prior to the expiration date of June 30, 2009, to provide for timely processing. The fees remain unchanged from prior years.

Home Medical Equipment Licenses and Certificates of Registration due to expire on June 30, 2009 will also be renewed this year. Application requirements are very similar to prior years, but the fee for renewal will be based on Section 737.10 under Sub. H.B. 562 of the 127th General Assembly. This section will allow the Board to proportionately reduce the renewal fee to allow the new license to expired on June 30, 2010 with other HME licenses and certificates of registration.

Board Investigator Transfers to Other Agency

Ohio law mandates that respiratory care providers advise the Board within sixty days of a change in address, name, or employment. Each biennial renewal, hundreds of renewal applications are returned, re-mailed, or lost due to old address information. If you have not kept the Board up-to-date, please do so.

CMS Issues Interim Final Rule for Home Medical Equipment “Competitive” Bidding

In an Press Release issued by the American Association for Homecare on January 15, 2009, the Center for Medicare/Medicaid Services (CMS) issued the interim final rule on “Competitive” bidding for Home Durable Equipment. The “Competitive” bidding rules will fulfill CMS’ requirement under the Medicare Improvements for Patients and Providers Act of 2008. The original program was delayed in July 2008. The new rules will go into effect on February 15, 2009.

New Equipment Deemed HME by Board

Under ORC Section 4752.01 (B)(3), the Ohio Respiratory Care Board is authorized to find that “Other” home medical equipment may be defined as home medical equipment for the purposes of Chapter 4752 regulation. The Board is required, under ORC Section 4752.01 (B)(3), to draft rules identifying the “Other” equipment that may be home medical equipment. The rules drafted by the Board list all categories of home medical equipment requiring a license or certificate of registration to offer home medical equipment services, including “Other” equipment. Under the rule, the Board identifies a “not limited to” list of equipment. By Board motion, additional equipment items have been approved as “Other” home medical equipment. A full list of these items are included on the Board’s website.

OAC rule 4761:1-3-02 list the following as home medical equipment:

“Life-sustaining equipment” including but not limited to:

- (1) Ventilators;
- (2) Oxygen Concentrators;
- (3) Oxygen Liquid Systems;
- (4) Oxygen Compressed Gas Systems;
- (5) Non Invasive Ventilator System (i.e. Bi-Level, Iron Lungs, Rocking Beds, Diaphragmatic pacers, etc.);

“Technologically-sophisticated” including but not limited to:

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| (1) Oxygen conservation devices; | (8) Percussors for chest physiotherapy; |
| (2) CPAP (continuous positive airway pressure) devices; | (9) Suction machines; |
| (3) Bi-level airway pressure (BiPAP) devices; | (10) Feeding pumps; |
| (4) Intrapulmonary percussive ventilation (IPV) devices; | (11) Infusion pumps; |
| (5) Intermittent positive pressure breathing (IPPB) devices; | (12) Continuous passive motion (CPM) devices; |
| (6) Cough-assist mechanical in-exsufflator; | (13) Transcutaneous electric nerve stimulators (TENS); |
| (7) Apnea monitors; | (14) Custom seating or positioning systems; |
| | (15) Custom rehab equipment (i.e. standers & gait trainers); |

“Other” including but not limited to:

- (1) Auto-titrating airway devices;
- (2) Pulse oximeters;
- (3) Home photo therapy (Bili lights or blankets);
- (4) Large volume air compressors for tracheostomy;
- (5) Electric wheelchairs and custom scooters;
- (6) In-home patient lifts;
- (7) Individually sized or customized accessories that are an integral part of equipment defined in paragraphs (A), (B), and (C) of this rule.

Since 2005, the Board has also included: Bone Growth Stimulators, Drop Foot Stimulators, and Vision Restoration Therapy (VRT) as “Other” HME.
